
## Understanding Your Paycheck: Biweekly Earnings Statement





- 1 Your current name and address in UCPath
- Your UCPath Employee ID number
- Your filing status and allowances for state and federal tax forms. Additional deductions as elected on your W-4 are now listed on your check
- 4 Earnings are now displayed in work week increments. Vacation and sick time are now included in hours and earnings display
- Your federal and state tax withholdings for this pay period and the year to date. The additional deductions listed in section three are included in these calculations
- Before tax and after-tax deductions are now displayed separately
- All contributions that UC pays on your behalf to health and welfare plans and retirement are listed
- OASDI (Social Security) and MED (Medicare) gross amounts are included in the display of current and year to date pay
- 9 The check number, account type and total amount of pay deposited to your accounts, with up to three direct deposit account options now available
